

# Inter-Base Supplement Sheet

## Example disc

The example disc supplied contains a series of programs and a database. See Appendix B of the Inter-Base manual for further information.

## Inter-Series ROM priority

Inter-Base is best positioned as the lowest priority ROM of any of the Inter-Series of ROMs. If Inter-Base is the highest priority then it will intercept all colon commands. For further information see the ROM-LINK section, section 22, of the Inter-Base manual. If Inter-Base is positioned correctly then it will appear after all other Inter-Series members when a **\*HELP** command is used.

## Filing Systems

The Card Index Program needs a filing system which can have 3 or more files open simultaneously. This is no problem, for filing systems like the Acorn DFS and ADFS which allow this automatically. With filing systems like the Solidisk ADFS the user is allowed to set up the maximum number of open files. For example, on the Solidisk ADFS, **\*OPEN 5** will allow 5 files to be open simultaneously, which would be ample for the Card Index Program. See the ADFS manual for further details.
